POSITION TITLE: International Research Intern

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

- ▶ **Conduct** market research for client firms or other regional organizations under the direction of the Director of Foreign Direct Investment, or other staff members. This will involve using in-house resources, databases, and outside sources.
- ▶ **Assist** with the maintenance of international trade databases to ensure information is current and accurate. Specifically, tracking the number of international businesses, exporters, importers, and foreign owned firms in the St. Louis area.
- ▶ **Support** the organizing of international trade training programs and seminars.
- ▶ **Perform** other duties as assigned, including assisting with programs and setting up conference rooms, assemble WTC folders, staffing registration tables, etc.

EXPECTATIONS:

- ▶ **Commitment** - Make a commitment of working 15 – 20 hours per week. Opportunities available for extended internship.
- ▶ **Confidentiality** - Maintain confidentiality on all projects worked. Statement of confidentiality must be signed.
