Dominic Têtu represents Invest Québec International as Director for Economic Affairs at Quebec's government office in Chicago since August 16th of 2021.

After a fruitful career in the private sector, Mr. Têtu entered public service in 2013 as an International Affairs advisor for the ministry of International Relations, Francophonie, and Foreign Trade (MRIFCE) and a few months later at Quebec Housing Society. In 2014, he joined Export Québec in an export promotion position where his role was to support Quebec companies' business development efforts in Mexico and Latin America.

In 2017, he was appointed as Director for Economic Affairs at Quebec General Delegation in Mexico City where he was in charge of coordinating all trade promotion activities with Quebec's third trading partner worldwide.

Mr. Têtu owns a bachelor's degree in History (B.A.) from Laval University and a master's degree in international relations (M.A.) from Quebec Institute for Advanced International Studies (IQHEI) at this same university. Mr. Têtu also studied at the Institute of International Relations (IRI) of the National University of La Plata, Argentina, and conducted investigation work at the United Nations Conference for Trade and Investment (UNCTAD) in Geneva, Switzerland.
